
RECONNAISSANCE DRONE RULES:

UNMANNED AERIAL VEHICLES - UAV/ UNMANNED GROUND VEHICLES- UGV(S):

Loyal Serpent will allow the use of private UAV/UAG during events until such a time that their use becomes detrimental to the enjoyment, fair play and safety of the event.

1. All private UAV / UGV(s) MUST be approved by Loyal Serpent staff prior to deployment.
2. UAV/UGV pilots must sign a waiver prior to deployment at Loyal Serpent events.
3. UAV/UGV pilots utilize their UAV/UGV with the full knowledge that they do so at their own risk. Operation Loyal Serpent assumes no liability for lost or damaged property.
4. UAV / UGV(s) will be used by Loyal Serpent staff to gather footage for promotion.
5. Offensive or defensive weapons may not be added to UAV / UGV's.

SAFETY GUIDELINES:

6. UAV / UGV must never be used in a manner that puts the safety of another player in jeopardy.
7. Players must stay at least 20 feet away from a UAV while taking off or landing
8. Gas powered Arial UAVs are not allowed.
9. UAV pilots must follow the rules in the *Canadian Aviation Regulations (CARs)*. [Part IX – Remotely Piloted Aircraft Systems](#) contains most of the rules that apply to AUV up to 25 kilograms. Pilots should read these regulations in full before they operate their UAV.
10. UAV pilots must be at least 18 years old to fly at Loyal Serpent events.

UAV / UGV GAME PLAY:

11. UAV / UGV(s) can be used as a means to conduct remote surveillance or battlefield reconnaissance.
12. UAV / UGV(s) must be operated within game parameters.
13. UAV / UAG pilots will be designated “Intelligence Specialists” for game play purposes.
14. If an Intelligence Specialist is “hit” while flying a UAV, they are allowed to land the UAV in a safe LZ. They are to yell “hit” followed by “recovering drone” so players understand what is happening.
15. In the case of a UAV coming down unexpectedly, the Intelligence Specialist may recover the UAV while they still have the crash site in their line of site. They will

pull their Dead Rag, forgo a bleed out time, yell “dead man walking” followed by “recovering drone”, and immediately recover their UAV. They then follow standard re-spawn procedure like any other KIA player.

16. A KIA Intelligence Specialist may recover a UAV / UGV, but the UAV / UGV may not be redeployed until after the Specialist returns to a CCP or re-spawn point.
17. Players **MAY NOT** shoot down, knock down, or otherwise damage, disable, capture, move, hide or interfere in any way with the operation of a UAV / UGV.
18. It is considered honourable for an opponent to identify, or point out, the location of a crashed UAV to its operator.
